The Item, appraisal report

One yellow and white gold ring that has been stamped 750. This ring features a single diamond that has been mounted into a four claw "peg" style setting mounted directly onto a yellow gold bridge. The shoulders flow from the band toward the diamond.

The overall height is 6.80 mm and the width is 5.58 mm. The band has a flat profile that measures 4.82 mm high x 2.32 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 2.14 mm wide x 1.82 mm thick at the base.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include the lost wax casting process (band) hand assembly, using machine fabricated components (setting) with traditional hand setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report **Claws** show up to 0 % wear, **Sides** show up to 0 % wear, **Band** shows up to 0 % wear. This ring is in new condition.

This item has been most likely imported into NZ comparable items are available through most New Zealand "high street" type jewellery stores. It has been valued in this market for market value new. **Market value (new)** sometimes called "replacement value" for a comparable item = **\$7,400.00**
