and 'Rectangular' shaped, 'push-in' and 'invisible' style "Clasp", with single hinged
and 'small' and 'Oval' shaped "Link" design "Safety-Chain" style "Assembly" and
hinge and 'attached' to either end.

Bracelet presented with Yellow gold and plain and half (1/2) round, and "Parallel" with
cut-out and pierced, and "Strip" design "in-situ" and applied to 'base' of 'Oval' shaped,
'polish-finish' 9.75mm x 3.80mm x 2.72mm dimension hinged style 'base' style
'Bangle' type "Assembly" setting.

Bracelet presented with Yellow gold, and Elevated, with (9) Psuedo/Doublets, with low
bead Pavé and 'part' and "rub-over" flush and inset, and cut-out and pierced, "in-situ"

(9) (single) Doublets/Pseudo presenting Good - Fair symmetry and proportions, with abraded crown facet junctions, with abraded crown facet junctions, and Nick/Cavities out of Crown/Girdle outline, with with High surface polish and presenting Nil - Noticeable Window effect, presenting a number of internal Gas-Bubbles and separation type Plane and a number of internal Healing Fracture and Rutile Needles and Positive and Negative Crystalite and Epitaxially Inter-grown syngenetic Rutile type inclusion scenes, applying (oblique lighting) and (immersion microscopy) technique, presented in mounts.

Alternate (Half) and "Seed" type Pearls:

16 x est 1.00-2.00mm

"Natural" and (non-drilled) and (Seed) (Half) type Pearls; presenting Irregular and 'Out of Round' shape, with White - Crème/White- Golden/Yellowish and Body type colour, presented with Rosé- Greyish/Greenish surface over-tone.

"Natural" and (non-drilled) and (Seed) (Half) type Pearls; presented with assorted with medium - high surface lustre and surface orient, with minor - slight noticeable surface blemishes, and presenting slight semi-translucent and degree of translucency, presented under (incandescence) light.

It is an internationally accepted trade practice to treat Pearls, including Pearls of this variety, to enhance the Lustre, using traditional methods, i.e. polishing - although evidence of treatment is not immediately apparent in these Pearls. As present testing methods, as used by this Laboratory, may not detect the type of treatment applied, some may be assumed. This appraisal has been prepared ONLY on the basis that traditional Methods have been applied.

N.B. Direct X-Ray radiograph-examination required to identify Nacre thickness and to identify if of "Natural" or "Fresh-Water - Tissue Grafted" and/or "Akoya" origin.
For the purposes of this appraisal all (Half) and "Seed" type (Pearls) appraised as "Natural" origin.
