"Specific use valuation and appraisal report"

Jewellery appraisal and valuation service requested for the use of obtaining insurance on the item presented by Sharman Buckle

The Item, appraisal report

One yellow and white metal ring that has been stamped 18 ct. This is a custom ring it features three oval sapphires that have all been rub over set with white metal tops and double collets. These are separated by groups of three diamonds made in a similar way and arranged in triangles. The band thickens and pinches in toward the settings.

The overall height is 4.15 mm and the width is 6.27 mm. The band has a slightly rounded profile that measures 4.00 mm high x 1.30 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 1.95 mm wide x 1.12 mm thick at the base.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report

Claws show up to 10% wear, **Sides** show up to 5% wear, **Band** shows up to 5% wear.

This item was most likely made circa 1970. It has been well cared for and is in near new condition. All stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

Gemmological appraisal report (with estimated characteristics)

Small diamonds

There are 6 small diamonds each is old single cut. Each measures 2.00 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are H/SI and the total weight is estimated at 0.18 cts.

Estimated Coloured Stone Characteristics

- Type = corundum.
- Variety = sapphire.
- Shape and size = oval /faceted/5.50x5.05 and 2 @5.10 mm x 3.80 mm.
- Treatment = none observed.
- Clarity = moderate.

The stones shows very moderate surface wear and abrasions.

The **hue**, (or colour) is described as slightly violet blue.

The **tone**, (or darkness) is described as (7) On a Scale 1 to 9 where 9 is black and 1 is nil

The **saturation**, (or intensity) of colour is described (6) on a scale of 1 to 10, where 0 is low and 10 is vivid.



Note. It is normal practice for all coloured stones to be treated in various ways to enhance the colour and appearance. If there is evidence of treatment it is noted, if not, some may be assumed. Advanced gemmological procedures may be required to prove.

VALUATION REPORT (market explanation) with additional comments on page four.

This item has been most likely custom made in NZ, the exact item is not available, however comparable items are available through high end retail manufacturing jewellers, on a make on request basis. It has been valued in this market for market value new.

Market value (new)" sometimes called "replacement value" for a comparable item = \$2,600.00

In this case there is some very slight wear and therefore an adjustment has been made to allow for this and to represent the market value of the item, in its current condition.

Market value (In its current condition)" sometimes called "indemnity value", present day value or fair value = \$2,400.00

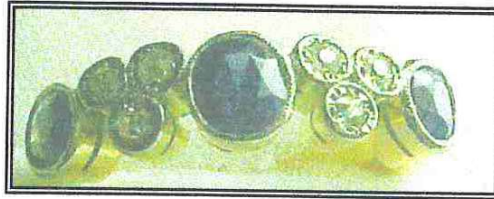
