The Item, appraisal report

One yellow and white gold ring that has been engraved 18 ct.

This ring features three large diamonds that have all been set into rex style coronets which rest on white gold collets. The shoulders flow straight from the band, pinching in and finishing by the settings. The overall height is 6.71 mm and the width is 7.48 mm. The band has a slightly rounded profile that measures 4.00 mm high x 2.05 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 3.09 mm wide x 1.28 mm thick at the base. This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using machine and hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report

Claws show up to 5% wear, **Sides** show up to 5% wear, **Band** shows up to 5% wear.

This item was most likely made circa 1990. It has been well cared for and is in near new condition. All stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

Gemmological appraisal report (with estimated characteristics)

Main diamond is Old Mine cut.

Colour = H/J
Dimensions = 6.46 mm x 4.00 mm deep
Weight = 1.26 cts
Clarity = I/1
Crown angle = 36 degrees
Table = 50% of the width of the diamond.
Culet = medium to large
Girdle = ground, small cleavage on girdle.

Main outer diamond are both Old Mine cut.

Weight = 1 x 0.55 cts, 1 x 0.615 cts
Clarity = VS/2
Crown angle = 36 degrees
Table = 50% of the width of the diamond.
Culet = medium to large

VALUATION REPORT (market explanation) with additional comments on page four.

This item has been most likely manufactured in NZ, the exact ring with older cut diamonds are seldom available new however comparable items are available from those retail jewellers who specialize in used sales of this type and age of items. It has been valued in this market for market value new.

Market value (new) sometimes called **"replacement value"** for a comparable item = **\$16,000.00**

In this case there is some very slight wear and therefore an adjustment has been made to allow for this and to represent the market value of the item, in its current condition.

Market value (in its current condition) sometimes called **"indemnity value"**, present day value or fair value = **\$15,800.00**

Should you require a new and single item to be made as close as possible to the original using modern day techniques with modern equivalent cut diamonds, then please use the cost estimate value. As this represents the most likely cost to buy from a retail manufacturing jeweller as a single bespoke piece. Note this value has been arrived at using the cost approach.
