Ring presented with Yellow gold, and flow-on to cut-out and plerced, "in-situ" and 'Loop' to "Strip" shaped, "Buttress" style "shoulder" setting, placed and applied to either side.

Ring presented with Yellow gold, and Elevated, and (1) and (single) and separate Turquoise, with "rub-over" flush and inset, with cut-out and pierced, "in-situ" and 'single' separate "Bezel" design, 7.52mm→ x 6.29mm → x 3.77mm → dimension and 'Oval' and "Parallel" and "Box" shaped, Tension inset, type 'pierced-back' and 'hollow-back' type central and "Assembly" style mount setting, and inset between shank ends

Centre Turquoise, modified, and "Oval" shaped, 'high' and (En-Cabochon) cut;
