The Item , report

One all white metal ring that has been stamped PLAT. This ring features three diamonds that have all been set into custom pierced claw settings with pierced hearts. These sit directly onto collets. The shoulders flow up from the band and finish in a point by the outer diamonds. The band is narrow and is fully engraved. The overall height is 4.60 mm and the width is 6.12 mm. The band has a flat profile that measures 3.77 mm high x 2.16 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 1.61 mm wide x 1.17 mm thick at the base.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition , report Claws show up to 40 % wear, Sides show up to 15 % wear, Band shows up to 5 % wear

This item has been most likely manufactured in NZ, the style is out of vogue and supply is limited ,however comparable items are available through those retail jewellery stores that specialize in sales of used jewellery of this type .It has been valued in this market for market value new .Market value (new)” sometimes called replacement value for a comparable item = \$5,800.00

In this case there is some very slight wear and therefore an adjustment has been made to allow for this and to represent the market value of the item ,in its current condition. Market value (in its current condition)” sometimes called indemnity value, present day value or fair value = \$5,400.00
