BANGLE... Traditional tanzanite, diamond and opal inlay snap..

Total Weight = 19.88 grams.

MOUNT.... is assembled cast in 14ct yellow gold, as tested by XRF metal analysis, stamped "14K585". 6.1mm tall wire claw and bezel setting into an integral 8.5mm wide tapered channel and flush setting head comprising twelve inlaid flat tablets, hinge to one side with a push in style clasp and safety clip, oval, plain tapered polished finish rear. Inside diameter 64 x 51mm.
In good condition.

TANZANITE... One is four claw set, oval mixed cut, approx 8.55 x 6.55 x 4.10mm, estimated 1.44 carats, medium bluish violet, appears eye clean, with good colour quality, and 40 % average brilliance.

***Note** Unless otherwise stated all coloured gemstones are assumed to have undergone colour and/or clarity enhancement treatments that do not require disclosure. Only treatments for which disclosure is required, and that have been identified, are reported here. Some disclosable treatments require advanced scientific testing to identify and may therefore not be reported.

DIAMONDS... Twenty eight are channel/grain set, round brilliant cut, approx 1.0-2.0mm, estimated to total 0.50 carats, with quality assessed in the setting as Good-Fair make, F-H colour, SI-I1 clarity.

OPALS... Twelve are inlaid, skewed rectangular tablets, approx 6.0-7.0 x 1.5-3.0 mm, natural type 1, with a blue-green play of colour, and black backing/seal.
