Item 1 of 1 A modern pendant, as a diamond set 'Heart', in white gold, on a white gold chain.

Description Heart is open at the centre, and has 20x diamonds, all 4 claw set, in open backed, double bezel style settings. It is approximately 18.40mm tall x 21.84mm across, approx. 3.83mm deep. At top centre is a small ring and a tapered 'V' shaped bail for the chain, open at the centre. Chain is a square 'Venetian Box' link style, approx. 40.50cm long x 1.13mm, with a small bolt ring clasp, and is machined production made.

Manufacture The pendant appears to be - assembled and hand finished production components.

Metal Pendant:- 18ct, as stamped & Hallmarked 750, London 'Import' mark for 1978.
Chain:-18ct, as stamped 750 on components, other stamps indicate 'Italian' origin.

Condition Good, has slight surface wear only.

Diamonds Setting restricts measurements. *No gem Information supplied, appraised as seen in the setting**:

Cut (20) **Round Brilliant** cut, Range approx. 2.30-2.40mmØ, calculated very approx. **1.00carats total** (+/-).

Grades Estimated grade range mounted: **Colour: H to K-L. Clarity: I1-I2. Cut/make: Poor.**

Note: Girdle- slightly thin to very thick.
