The Item, appraisal report

One all white metal spray brooch that has been stamped PLAT. This brooch has been made in a classic flower and leaf style with small diamonds set, grain style as highlights. The overall height is 46.03 mm and the width is 24.20 mm.

This brooch has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report Claws show up to 2% wear,

This item was most likely made circa 1970. It has been well cared for and is in new condition. All stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

Gemmological appraisal report (with estimated characteristics)

Larger flower diamond

There is one larger floral diamond which is modern brilliant cut. Each measures 3.20 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **GH/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.14 cts.

Small leaf diamonds

There are 33 small diamonds each is single cut. Each measures 1.40 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **GH/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.33 cts.

Small petal diamonds

There are 7 small diamonds each is single cut. Each measures 1.80 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **GH/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.14 cts.

Larger leaf diamonds

There are 2 small diamonds each is single cut. Each measures 1.80 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **GH/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.04 cts.
