#### The Item, appraisal report

One all white metal pendant that has not been stamped. Readily apparent identification indicates the pendant to be made from platinum. The chain has been stamped 925 (sterling silver). This pendant has been made in the "Deco style". It features three main diamonds which have been elevated and set with a combination of rims and box and grain style. The other diamonds have been set in a similar way. The overall height is 25.62 mm and the width is 9.91 mm.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

#### Condition, appraisal report Claws show up to 5% wear,

This item was most likely made circa 1920. It has been well cared for with some modification from an original ring and is in good condition. All stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

#### Gemmological appraisal report (with estimated characteristics)

##### Small main diamond

There is one small centre diamond which is old mine cut and which measures 3.20 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are H/SI and the total weight is estimated at 0.13 cts.

##### Small side diamonds

There are 2 small diamonds each is old mine cut. Each measures 2.60 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are H/SI and the total weight is estimated at 0.12 cts.

##### Small diamonds

There are 6 small diamonds each is old mine cut. Each measures 2.40 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are H/SI and the total weight is estimated at 0.30 cts.

##### Small rub over set diamonds

There are 4 small diamonds each is old mine cut. Each measures 1.80 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are H/SI and the total weight is estimated at 0.06 cts.
