The ring features a 10.88ct Emerald, Cut-Square Emerald Cut, Colour-Green, Tone-Dark, Clarity-Included to Opaque four claw set in the centre with 108 Round Brilliant Cut Diamonds totaling 0.40ct claw set along a double row around the outer edge of the centre setting and 36 Round Brilliant Cut Diamonds totaling 0.15ct claw set along the sides of the centre setting Clarity SI2-P2, Colour J-L.

The band is slightly rounded with a polished finish measuring 2.00mm wide at the base of the shank with the two shoulders sweeping up and flaring out into a split to join onto the sides of the centre setting.
