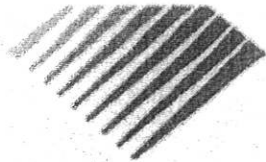

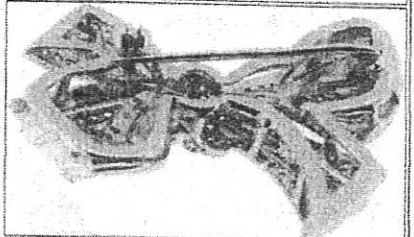
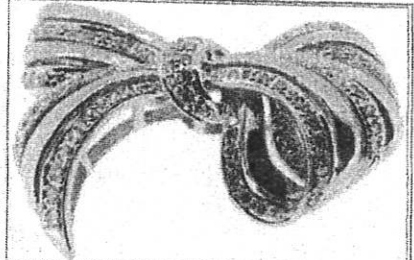

### Fine Diamond Bow Style Brooch:

Centre front of the bow, a 'waisted' diamond encrusted ribboned bow motif secures 4 flowing ribbon sections with each ribbon having two outer border ajoure lines, diamond encrusted alternating with ajoure plain high polish yellow gold centre sections. Three under 'ribbons' are also diamond encrusted. Verso, a double open-work frame is high polish finished with a modern brooch hinge, bar to pierce and a revolving safety catch to secure, all modern type cast manufactured fittings. It is stated by the owner, this brooch was a gifted to her from the **Royal Bolkiah Family of Brunel**.
