The pendant features a 13.18ct Kunzite, Cut-Oval Faceted Colour-Purplish Pink, Tone-Medium to Strong, Clarity-Slightly Included double four claw set in the centre with 24 Round Brilliant Cut Diamonds totaling 0.22ct bead set around the outer edge of the centre oval shaped setting and 13 Round Brilliant Cut Diamonds totaling 0.10ct bead set along the front of the bail Clarity SI1-P2, Colour I-K.
The pendant has a 14ct white gold fixed tapered bail and measures 30.0mm in total length.
The necklace is a 14ct white gold fine wire belcher link with 4 Round Brilliant Cut Diamonds Clarity SI1-P2, Colour I-K totalling 0.12ct set in four individual bezel settings. The necklace measures 50.0cm in total length (also adjustable to 46.0cm) and has a 14ct white gold parrot clasp lock.
