The Item, appraisal report

One all white gold solitaire style ring that has been stamped 14K . This ring features a single older cut diamond that has been held in a high six claw setting that sits directly onto a flat tapered band . The overall height is 7.25 mm and the width is 5.83 mm. The band has a flat textured profile which measures 1.41mm high x 2.90 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 1.41 mm wide x 1.13 mm thick at the base.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include hand assembly, using hand fabricated components with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report Claws show up to 5 % wear. Sides show up to 15 % wear. Band shows up to 20 % wear. This item was most likely made circa 1960. It has been well cared for , but there is some wear to the band texture and is in good overall condition. All stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.
