The Item, appraisal report

One all white ladies mechanical wrist watch that has been stamped Pt.
The watch has been made by Movado (Swiss). It features a light grey dial with accents at intermediate and Arabic numbers at the quarters.
The dial has been set with 22 small grain set diamonds.
The bracelet has been made in a "Tennis" style with diamonds box and grain set in each link. The clasp is box style with double safety clips.
Case number is 301/9106 by Vertex.
Movement number is 7772 with 17 jewels.
The watch is in working order.

Condition, appraisal report see notes page 4. **Claws** show up to 40 % wear, **Clasp** shows up to 5 % wear, **Bracelet** links shows up to 5 % wear.

This item was most likely made circa 1960. It has been well cared for and shows light overall wear. Major stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

Gemmological appraisal report (with estimated characteristics)

Small dial diamonds

There are 22 small diamonds each is single. Each measures 1.40 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **EFG/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.22 cts.

Small shoulder diamonds

There are 12 small diamonds each is modern brilliant cut. Each measures 2.20 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **EFG/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.50 cts.

Small bracelet diamonds

There are 6 small diamonds each is single cut. Each measures 1.40 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **H/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 0.12 cts.

Larger bracelet diamonds

There are 36 small diamonds each is single cut. Each measures between 2.40 mm and 2.20 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are **H/SI** and the total weight is estimated at 1.80 cts.

Total estimated diamond weight 2.64 carats.



VALUATION REPORT (market explanation) with additional comments on page four.

This item has been most likely privately imported into New Zealand the watch is no longer produced, comparable items are available through International retail specialist vintage watch sellers. It has been valued in this market for market value new.

Market value (new) sometimes called "**replacement value**" for a comparable item = \$3,800.00

In this case there is some very slight wear and therefore an adjustment has been made to allow for this and to represent the market value of the item, in its current condition.

Market value (in its current condition) sometimes called "**indemnity value**", present day value or fair value = \$3,500.00
