

Art Deco, circa 1930's, signed by Feagans & Co, (Los Angeles, Ca). An oval case, 23.0x 20.6mm, with a round faceted yellow diamond for watch glass, on an integral articulated bracelet tapering 11.0mm at lugs to 8.0mm at clasp, which is a concealed tongue type. To fit a 17.5cm wrist. A pair of calibre-cut sapphires, custom-cut, are set at lugs with a line of 18x step-cut sapphires down either side of bracelet, flanked entirely down each side with a line of 86x single-cuts, bead-set, edges millegrained. The sides of case & links are flat, engraved in repeating fan style. The watch case is signed by Charles Holl and is French hallmarked. The dial is attributed to Lucina, cream with Arabic quarters and dots. The movement is a 17j manual wind Swiss, by Dauville Watch Co. The case & bracelet are in very good condition, movement appears intact and in working order, the dial has discoloured. A safety chain is threaded along one side of the case/ bracelet. The case No. is 52865, also stamped on the clasp.


