**Ruby and Diamond Ring**

One lady's 18K yellow and white gold ruby and diamond ring. The domed tapered ring shank has upswept curving, pointed shoulders rising to the sides of two offset round white gold cluster settings with claw set diamonds, each surrounding a central claw set ruby.

The ring is set with:

Two (2) round mixed cut rubies measuring approximately 4.00 - 4.10 x 2.15-2.33mm:

Total estimated weight, by gauge: 0.60ct.

Clarity: Noticeable inclusions, in addition to abraded crown facets

Colour: Medium dark, moderately strong to strong purplish red

Cutting grade: Fair

Sixteen (16) single cut diamonds measuring approximately 1.80 - 1.90mm in diameter :

Total estimated weight, by gauge: 0.40ct.

Clarity: SI-1 to I-1

Colour: F-G-H (estimated due to the nature of the setting).

Cutting grade: 3 to 5

The ring is stamped "750" with hallmarks for Birmingham 1976, and weighs 5.52 grams.
