One lady's hand-assembled diamond and ruby-set 18ct yellow and white gold cluster ring, narrow, half round, ribbed, tapered shank, with an open collet style under-rail, ribbed shoulders, claw and bead-set diamonds (x12) around a centre raised four claw-set ruby on a gallery style undersetting, polished finish, stamped (750).

Twelve claw and bead-set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "VS-SI", colour is "G-I", medium cut quality.

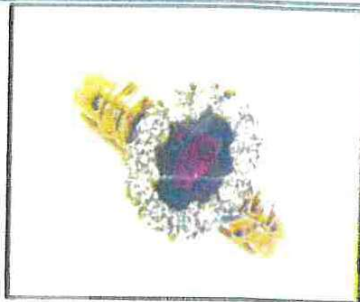
