Ruby and Diamond Wide Dress Style Ring:

Centre front of the wide open-worked band are 5 rows of rubies alternated with diamonds all 4-claw co-joined held above spaced collets with 5 split curved shoulder rails each outer side.

Details of Gemstones:

Rubies:22: Oval mixed cut medium-dark tone, strongly saturated fine Red color all well matched. One border ruby has a medium sized girdle chip, SI1 clarity grade (Type 11 Gemstone). These rubies may have had a treatment of heat.

Measure: 4.1 x 3.1mm diameters x 1.85mm depth = **0.202 carat** average approx each

Total Ruby Weight: 4.46 carat

Diamonds:23: Round modern brilliant cut

Measure: 2.7mm diameter = **0.053 carat approx**

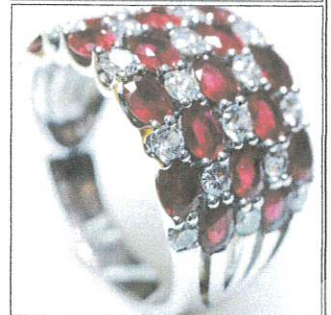
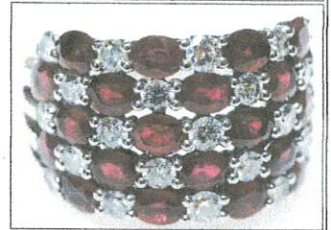
