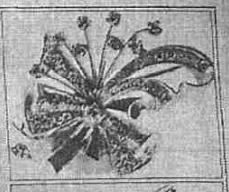

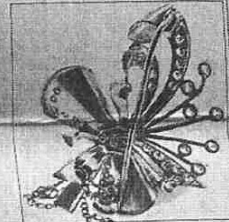
Estate Diamond Spray Style Brooch:

Centre front, a larger raised diamond is 6-claw held with flaring scroll, curling ribbons encrusted with 8/8 cut diamonds, 4 lower flaring matt finished lower 'ribbons' and 5 diamonds end mounted on flaring wire stem terminals, 3 diamonds are held between stems all claw held, milligrain and bead detailing. Verso, a modern brooch hinge, bar and revolving brooch clasp are to secure. A silver safety chain and pin are secured to a solid bale.

Centre: 1: Antique Cushion Cut
Measures: 4.3 x 4.0mm diameter x 3.00mm depth (est) = 0.346 carat approx
Clarity: SI1-SI2. Color: L (very light yellow—champagne diamond)

Measure: 1.4—2.1mm diameters = 0.028 carat average approx each
