The Item, appraisal report

One yellow and white gold ring that has been stamped 750 the stylised letter P (the mark of Partridge jewellers, a national retail jeweller). This ring features a single diamond that has set into a white gold "rub over" mounting with a lower rim of gold. This sits directly onto a raised white gold shoulder that has been set with eight diamonds and two yellow gold bands of gold.

The overall height is 5.80 mm and the width is 9.00 mm. The band has a very slightly rounded profile which measures 3.00 mm high x 6.50 mm wide at the shoulder and tapers to 4.40 mm wide x 0.90 mm thick at the base.

This ring has been handcrafted using a variety of techniques, which include the lost wax casting process hand assembly, with traditional hand forming, setting and finishing.

Condition, appraisal report see notes page 4. Claws show up to 5 % wear, Sides show up to 5 % wear, Band shows up to 10 %

This item was most likely made circa 2020 . It has been well cared for and shows light overall wear. Major stones have been checked and found to be tight and secure in the settings at the time of inspection.

There are 8 small diamonds each is modern brilliant cut. Each measures 2,30 mm in width, the colour and clarity grades are F/SI/VS and the total weight is estimated at 0.42 cts

In this case there is some very slight wear and therefore an adjustment has been made to allow for this and to represent the market value of the item, in its current

Market value (in its current condition) sometimes called ,indemnity value, or present day value or fair value = \$9,000.00
