



Estate Sapphire Dress Style Bracelet:

A centre hinged section has 3 daisy cluster mounts, the centre mount is larger, each with a blue sapphire 4-claw held above a border of colorless synthetic sapphires, 10 in the centre mount and 9 in each of the side mounts, all bead held in white gold above yellow gold pierced convex mounts with kite shaped end mounts each with 3 synthetic sapphires bead held in individual shaped mount. Each side of the centre mount is a rectangular mount of white gold over yellow gold back mount with 2 synthetic sapphires Bead. Each side are fold-over convex links 4 on one side and 5 on the other to the rectangular push clasp with a safety chain attached to end bracelet end.





Details of Gemstones:

Natural Blue Sapphires;3: Round mixed cut, two are dark very slightly Blue and one sapphire is medium tone greenish-Blue colors of Australian type. The centre larger sapphire has 2 crown table facet scratches. Centre @ 5.8mm diameter x 2.82mm depth = 0.681 carat approx
