

DOCUMENTATION FOR INSURANCE



BANGLE... modern diamond and sapphire.

Total Weight = 40.02 grams.

MOUNT... is handmade in rhodium plated 9ct white gold, stamped "375" 9.7mm wide and 1.8mm thick, plain polished with square and round shot settings alternating across top. Oval in side profile, 65mm at widest point. In good condition.

DIAMONDS... Five are set, Princess cut, very approx 2x2 mm, estimated to total 0.25 carats, with quality assessed in the setting as Very Good major symmetry, E-G colour, VS-SI clarity.

SAPPHIRES... 6 are set, round brilliant cut, approx 2.5 mm, estimated to total 0.60 carats, medium pink, of good quality.

*Note Unless otherwise stated all coloured gemstones are assumed to have undergone colour and/or clarity enhancement treatments that do not require disclosure. Only treatments for which disclosure is required, and that have been identified, are reported here. Some disclosable treatments require advanced scientific , testing to identify and may therefore not be reported.
