The Bracelet: The bracelet is made up of 6.00mm to 6.50mm Akoya cultured pearls in 3 rows knotted on white pearl thread with gympe ends.

There are 2 groups of 8 in each row, 24 in each section. With a grouping of 6 in the centre and 3 pearls at each end.

60 pearls in total.

The pearls are full rounds.

White light pink rose overtones.

Presenting good nacre layer and lustre.

Some pearls slightly blemished.

Colour grade relatively even.

The bracelet is spaced with 4 rectangular shaped 9ct rose gold spacers.

Overall length: 18.00cm.

The Clasp: Oval shaped 9ct rose gold. Dimensions: 17.00mm x 15.00mm.

With a 6.00mm x 4.00mm central cabochon cut sapphire full rub over set.

Deep blue in colour.

The clasp is a push in tension styled clasp.

Total weight: 28.00 grams.
