The ring consists of a round brilliant cut diamond set in a mathey eight claw tapered coronet setting on a bezel base. The setting is joined to a narrow half round band with flow on tapering upswept shoulders with chenier inserts. The band measures 1.68mm in width, 0.80mm in thickness, and the setting measures 10.77 x 5.91mm.

Finger size: 01/2. Item weight: 2.90 grams.

Presented in very good condition showing minimal signs of wear.

Comments: Multiple XRF tests conclude the ring has been manufactured using 14 carat white gold setting and a platinum band. Incorrectly hallmarked: 20ct.
