Pendant presented with Yellow gold, and Elevated, and (1) (single) and separate Tahitian Cultured Pearl, flush and single "Cup" and "Peg" 3.08mmØ x 0.50mm↑ dimension and 'Inset' style, "in-situ" design mount "Assembly" setting, applied to 'base' of (Drop/Suspended) design central style "Assembly" setting.

(Tahitian) Cultured (half-drilled) Pearl presenting irregular - Spherical slightly Out of Round shape, with Medium - high surface lustre, and presented with Black - Greyish/Green and Body type colour, with Lime/Green, slight Royal Blue surface over-tone, and minor - surface blemishes, presented under (incandescent) light.

(Tahitian) Cultured Pearl presenting extra Thick 1.30mm↑ Nacré thickness.





N.B. Check (1) (single) and (7.00cmØ x 5.00cm↑) direct X-Ray radiograph.

N.B. Direct single X-Ray radiograph-examination indicate Pearls of (Beaded) (Cultured) and "Tahitian" origin.

For the purposes of this appraisal these (Pearls) graded as (Cultured) "Tahitian" origin.

It is an internationally accepted trade practice to treat Pearls, including Pearls of this variety, to enhance the Lustre, using traditional methods, i.e. polishing - although evidence of treatment is not immediately apparent in these Pearls. As present testing methods, as used by this Laboratory, may not detect the type of treatment applied, some may be assumed. This appraisal has been prepared ONLY on the basis that traditional Methods have been applied.

N.B. Cultured (Tahitian) Pearl presenting and graded in mount (*in-situ*).
Cultured (Tahitian) Pearl length- & diameterØ & depth↑ dimension measurements estimated due to mounts.
