

AN OPAL SET DRESS RING

Cast assembled in 18 carat yellow gold, tested using XRF metal analysis
Hallmarks: 750

The ring consists of a freeform oval black opal cabochon doublet, in a yellow gold rubover bezel setting. The setting is joined to yellow gold half round profile tapering grooved band with a domed centre and upswept shoulders. The band measures 2.53 - 4.84mm in width, 0.80 - 2.86mm in thickness, and the setting measures 14.00 x 8.50 x 4.00mm.



Finger size: O. Item weight: 4.51 grams.
