Cormack was a gold mining engineer and long time resident of Blue Spur in the Tuapeka district. An expert in hydraulic sluicing Cormack became manager of the Rise and Shine claim at Pomahoka in the 1890s, he worked in Tasmania as mine manager of the Savage River Hydraulic Gold Mining Company.
