Signed Horatio Nelson lower right. This was a constant hazard to naval officers of the period and Nelson, who was then in the Mediterranean no doubt remembered the unpleasantness when he was a captain in the West Indies during the American War of Independence and seized many West Indian vessels on suspicion of their illegal commerce with the Americans. \$10,000 - \$15,000
